Foundation for Youth is a 501 (c) 3 nonprofit. Since then, Bartholomew County residents have made kids a priority by establishing and funding FFY to support families.

Our Donor Bill of Rights:

Philanthropy is based on voluntary action for the common good. It is a tradition of giving and sharing that is primary to the quality of life in our community. To ensure that philanthropy merits the respect and trust of the general public, and that donors and prospective donors can have full confidence in Foundation for Youth, we declare that all donors have these rights:

- I. To be informed of our mission, of the way we intend to use donated resources, and of our capacity to use donations effectively for their intended purposes.
- II. To be informed of the identity of those serving on our governing board, and to expect the board to exercise prudent judgment in its stewardship responsibilities.
- III. To have access to our most recent financial statements.
- IV. To be assured your gifts will be used for the purposes for which they were given.
- V. To receive appropriate acknowledgement and recognition.
- VI. To be assured that information about your donation is handled with respect and with confidentiality to the extent provided by law.
- VII. To expect that all relationships with individuals representing FFY to the donor will be professional in nature.
- VIII. To be informed whether those seeking donations are volunteers or employees.
- IX. To have the opportunity for your name to be deleted from mailing lists on request.
- X. To feel free to ask questions when making a donation and to receive prompt, truthful and forthright answers.
